The conference is for all stakeholders and experts interested in Green Maritime.

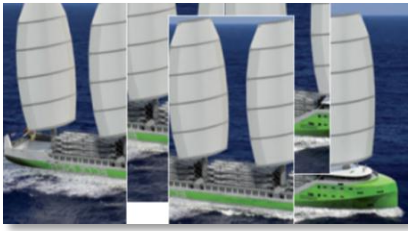
